Dorchester Fair Parade Rules & Regulations

1. Completed applications MUST be returned to parade chairman by September 1, 2019. Todd Arthur at arthurtodd@icloud.com
2. The parade will take place Saturday October 12th 2019.
3. All participants must be ready in the staging area in the front parking lot of the Dorchester arena/Flight Exec Centre by 8:30am for judging.
4. There is limited parking at the arena so we ask participants to park at the Foodland/Dollarama parking lot across the street.
5. Parade leave promptly at 10:30am
6. All vehicles in the parade must be driven by a licensed driver.
7. Please DO NOT throw candy. Candy may be handed out by walkers alongside your parade entry. Please not that political candidate is not allowed to hand out candy or flyers.
8. No pets allowed on your float.
9. Junior Riders on horseback must wear approved helmets while riding in the parade. We recommend that all riders wear helmets regardless of age.
